#### Maui April 2017 Statistics

Aloha all!

#### **Brief Maui Statistics Overview:**

**Page 4 - April's Sales Unit Volume** – Residential sales reflect the High Season's closings with 97 homes sold while Condominium sales decreased to 116 units sold. Land sales increased to 18 lots sold in April.

**Page 5 - April's Median SALES prices –** The Residential median price decreased to a more normal \$671,000 after March's high of \$756,000 (highest since Sept. 2006). The Condo median price rebounded to \$490,563. Land median price remained steady \$404.750.

Page 6 - Days on Market, Residential homes = 88, Condos = 134 DOM, Land = 133 DOM.

(General DOM Note: this is the average DOM for the properties that SOLD. If predominantly OLD inventory sells, it will move this indicator upward, and vice versa. RAM's Days on Market are calculated from List Date to Closing Date [not contract date], including approximately 60 days of escrow time.)

Pages 10 - 14 – This month's "Year to Date Sales" numbers compare <u>only four months</u>, <u>January-April</u> <u>2017 to January-April 2016</u>. Shorter timeframe (monthly) views do not necessarily reflect the longer timeframe trends.

YTD - Residential unit sales declined somewhat compared to 2016 (329 homes sold / -12 units / -4% change YTD), average sold price = \$997,319 (+13% change YTD), median price = \$685,000 (+11% change YTD) and total dollar volume sold = \$328,118,081 (+9%YTD).

YTD - Condo unit sales increased (458 units sold / +41 units sold/ +10% change YTD), average sold price = \$675,205 (+4% change YTD), median price = \$480,625 (+9%YTD). Total Condo dollar volume sold = \$309,244,012 (+14% change YTD).

YTD - Land – NOTE: Land Lot sales are such a small sampling that statistics in this property class are not necessarily reliable indicators. The number of Land lot sales decreased (50 lots / -4 lots sold / -7% YTD change), average sold price = \$450,446 (-23%), median price = \$391,000 (-21% change), Total dollar volume = \$22,522,300 (-29% YTD).

Total sales for immediate past 12 months: Residential = 1,065 (with 10% being REO or Short Sale), Condo = 1,354 (5.4% REO or SS), Land = 157 (1.3% REO or SS).

NOTE: 37.2% of these Sales in the last 12 months have been CASH transactions.

Current Absorption Rate base on this month's <u>Active/Pending-Continue to Show/Contingent status</u> inventory divided by April Sales: Residential 734 / 97 Sold = 7.6 months, Condo = 890/116 Sold = 7.7 months, Land 376 / 18 Sold = 20.9 months of inventory.

For Absorption Rate enthusiasts who calculate only pure "Active," (not any pending/contingent) divided by April Sales: Residential 543 "Active"/ 97 Sold = 5.6 months. Condo 699 / 116 Sold = 4.2 mos. Land 322 / 18 Sold = 17.8 months of inventory.

IN A NUT SHELL..... Residential and Condo Prices continue trending upward. Inventory increased for High Season (Dec. - March) and is now declining a bit n Condos. Canadian investors have been big participants in Maui's real estate market in years past, however the current Canadian Dollar exchange rate (.73 US \$) may motivate Canadian investors to sell, rather than buy OR sell and reinvest in other Maui properties.

Increased showings and sales, multiple offers on "well priced" listings, hesitant buyers may become onlookers...... Window of opportunity is quickly closing for first-time homebuyers (see below). "CASH is King!" when making an offer. For several months approximately 37% of all sales were CASH. Well priced properties are attracting multiple offers making for a quick sale. REO (Foreclosures) and Short Sales are dwindling, with any "hidden inventory" (or overhang) backlog slowly trickling onto the market. Mortgage Interest Rates are ratcheting up which may help motivate would-be Buyers to go ahead and buy IF they can qualify. Savvy Investors are buying with Cash, giving them a strong negotiating position, no financing /appraisal hassles and a quick closing. While general U.S. economic news looks cautiously hopeful, current World and US events and "The New Administration" will have ripple effects on cost of living, consumer confidence, Financial and Real Estate Markets.

Rising Sales prices motivate some "Owners" to become "Sellers," putting their homes on the market.

FOR SELLERS: Sharpen your pencil, talk to your CPA and your Realtor® to explore the hidden benefits or consequences. Make no assumptions that will sting later.

**To be successful,** Sellers need to beat competing properties with better property condition, <u>realistic pricing,</u> good marketing, and flexible, creative terms. Days on Market figures show that properties <u>priced right</u> will sell in a reasonable timeframe, often with multiple offers. "Priced Right" is still the determining factor.

BEST Deals are selling, while significantly over-priced listings remain un-sold.

**Pro-Active Sellers** are getting their properties **appraised**, **inspected and surveyed** in advance to encourage realistic offers from knowledgeable Buyers. This can prevent unanticipated escrow fallout or Buyers whittling your price down during the transaction when previously unknown facts come to light.

**FOR BUYERS:** Interest rates have started to nudge up. Buyers should get **Pre-Approved** so they can shop in confidence (fewer last minute disappointments due to non-funding loans). **Veterans:** Check out your VA Loan options. "Short-sales" and foreclosures are still in the marketplace, yet they can be less of a bargain than they seem, requiring more hurdles to leap and more time (often 4-6-12 months) to close, if at all. Be prepared, but BE REALISTIC. Lenders are more stringent on requirements now for loan approval, compared to 2004-2008.

<u>First-Time Home Buyers</u> – Many programs are available..... Attend a First-Time Home Buyers workshop, get familiar with the process, get qualified/approved, do your homework to get your own home. Many current owners never thought they would be able to own until they attended a workshop, discovered they could own a home, and are glad they did.

The low point in the market has passed, so check it out carefully NOW, don't delay. The opportunity is fading quickly. If you cannot buy now, start saving your down payment for the next market cycle.

Disclaimer: Zooming in on the figures of a specific geographic area or property type may lead to different conclusions that looking at the overall view.

Maui's market place is much smaller than Oahu's, and a few high or low sales have a greater effect on the statistical numbers without necessarily indicating a big market swing one way or another.






